

Resurvey of <sup>W.</sup> Boundary of T. 29 N. R. 51 E.

Chains. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of cor, Pits impracticable. Change course to N. 00. 1' E.

42.00 Proceed nearly level.

65.00 Draw, course NW.

67.10 Spur, bears E. and W.

76.00 Draw, course W.

84.00 Spur, bears E. and W.

96.00 Draw, course W.

161.84 The old cor. of Tps. 29 N. R's 50 and 51 E. A granite stone 18x12x9 ins. lying in a mound of scattered stones. I destroy all traces of the old cor and in same place I set a granite stone 18x12x9 ins. 12 ins in the ground, for the NE. cor. of T. 29 N. R. 50 E., marked 29 N 50 E. on the Sw. face with 6 notches on the S. and W. edges and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft, high SW. of cor. Pits impracticable.

( Note: From information already found in the field I find this cor will refer to 1 township only, consequently I built it as such.)

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N 89o 53' W. on the N. bdy of Sec 1. of T. 29 N. R. 50E.

47.18 The cor. of Tps. 30 N. R's 50 and 51 E. A rhyolite stone 18x8x8 ins. lying loose with no witness mound. I destroy all traces of the old cor. and as this cor. will refer to 1 Tp. only, after closing against the range line I rebuild as follows, in the same place. I set a rhyolite stone 18x8x8 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for SE corner of T. 30 N. R 50 E., marked 30 N 50 E, on the NW, face with 6 notches on the N. and W. edges; dig pits 36x36x12 ins. on each line N. and W. of stone 8 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth , 5 ft. base  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high NW. of cor.
