

## Survey of N. Boundary of T. 28 N R. 51 E.

Chains

Sept. 1st. 1909.

At 6 h. 54' m. A.M. l.m.t. I set off 80 25' N. on the decl. arc and 40 25' on the lat. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N. R's. 51 and 52 E. Thence I run, W. on a true line bet. secs 1 and 36.

Proceed up gentle slope in valley.

Set an andesite stone 12x8x6 ins. 8 ins in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the N. face; adig. pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of stone 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft, high N. of cor.

Proceed up slight grade in valley.

Set an andesite stone, 14x10x5 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 35, 36, 1 and 2 marked with 1 notch on the E. and 5 notches on the W. edge and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.
