- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 16-10-7 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 31 and 32, marked with 5 notches on the E. and 1 notch on the W. edge and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor.  
Pits impracticable.  
Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky. 4th. rate.  
Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

- 62.04 Ridge, bears N. and S.

- 87.40 Ridge, bears N.E. and S.W. Begin descending.
- 99.97 Intersect W. bdy of Tp. at S. 1.71 chs. from the temp. Tp. cor. set by me on June 13, 1910. This makes the W. bdy. of sec. 6, 78.29 chs. in length.  
Set a porphyry stone, 24-12-10 ins., 16 ins. in the ground for cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N, Rs. 22 and 23 E, marked 35 N on N.E., 23 E on S.E., 34 N on S.W. and 22 E on N.W. face and with 6 notches on each edge and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high S. of cor.  
Pits impracticable.  
Land, rolling and hilly.  
Soil, rocky. 3rd. rate.  
Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass.
