

Subdivision of T 37 N, R 22 E, Mt. Diablo B. and M.

Chains

July 21, 1910.

I begin at the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

S 0° 2' E on a true line bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Over mountainous land.

5.60 Ridge, bears E. and W. Begin descending.

28.05 Ravine, course S.W. Begin ascending.

32.00 Ridge, bears E. and W. Begin descending.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 17-12-6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

40.67 The dry bed of Negro creek, course S.E. Begin ascending.

74.82 Intersect the S. bdy. of the Tp. at E., 12.11 chs. from the cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set a volcanic stone 21-11-5 ins., 14 ins. in the ground for closing corner to secs. 33 and 34, marked C C on N.; with 3 grooves on the E. and W. faces and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor. Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky. 4th. rate.

Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

Mountainous land, 74.82 chs.

From the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34 I run:

N 0° 2' W bet. secs. 27 and 28

Over rolling ground.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 18-12-4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

58.00 Ravine, course E. Ascend gentle slope.

80.00 Set a basalt stone ,27-10-6 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, marked with 2 notches on the S. and 3 notches on the E. edge and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high, W. of cor.
