2 0.10	Ridge, bears N.W. and S.E. Begin descending.
36.40	Ravine, course S.E.
40.00	On a small ridge bearing E. and W., set a basalt stone 18-8-4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high W. of cor.
	Pits impracticable.
46.00	Ravine, course E. Begin ascending.
50.30	Ridge, bears E. and W. Begin descending.
55.90	Broad ravine, course N.E. Begin ascending N.W. slope of hill.
74.90	Intersect the S. bdy. of the Tp. at E., 11.80 chs. from the cor. of secs. 4 and 5.
	Set a basalt stone 16-10-6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 32 and 33, marked C C on N.; with 4 grooves on E. and 2 grooves on W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor.
