

Chains

Land, level and rolling.
 Soil, meadow loam and rocky. 1st. and 4th. rate.
 Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass.
 July 26, 1910.

July 27, 1910.

I begin at the cor, of secs. 29,30,31 and 32.

Thence I run

S 0° 4'E on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Descending over mountainous land.

10.00 Ravine, course E. Begin ascending.

29.75 Ridge, bears N.W. and S.E.

40.00 Set a basalt stone, 21-9-4 ins., 14 ins. in the ground
 for 1-4 sec. cor., marked with 1-4 on the W. face and
 raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high W. of cor.
 Pits impracticable.

48.50 Enter mahogany thicket.

74.85 Intersect the S. bdy. of the Tp. at E., 9.35 chs. from
 the cor. of secs. 5 and 6.

Set a volcanic stone 18-10-4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground
 for closing corner of secs. 31 and 32, marked C C on N.;
 with 5 grooves on E. and 1 groove on W. face; and raise
 a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor.
 Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky. 4th. rate.

Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass and mahogany trees.

Mountainous land, 74.85 chs.

I begin again at the cor. of secs. 29,30,31 and 32

Thence I run

N 0° 4'W bet. secs. 29 and 30

Descending over mountainous land.

16.10 Deep ravine, course N.W. Begin ascending.

29.30 Ridge, bears E. and W. Begin descending, along E. side
 of creek.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 18-13-4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground
