14.60	Wire fence, bears N.E. and S.W. Enter potato field.
19.70	Leave potato field.
20.20	The dry bed of Squaw Valley creek, course S. Begin ascending.
28.40	Top of bank from creek. Thence across level land.
33.33	Wire fence, bears N.W. and S.E.
40.00	Set a basalt stone 18-13-5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the N. face and dig pits 18-18-12 ins., E. and W. of stone 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 3 1-2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor. Begin ascending across rolling land.
78.80	Ridge, bears N. and S.
80.00	Set a basalt stone 16-10-5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32; marked with 5 notches on the E. and 1 notch on the W. edge and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable. Land, level and rolling. Soil, good loam and rocky. 1st. and 4th. rate Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

53.10	Rocky ridge, bears N. and S. Begin descending.
57.00	Ravine, bears N.E. Begin ascending.
72.60	Ridge, bears N. and S. Begin descending.
90.00	Ravine, course S.E. Begin ascending.
106.70	Intersect the E. bdy. of T 34 N, R 21 E, at N 0 51'W, 20.00 chs. from the cor. of Tps. 33 and 34 N, R 21 E. Set a basalt stone 21-7-5 ins., 14 ins. in the ground
