for closing corner of Tps. 33 and 34 N, R 22 E; marked C C on E., 34 N on N., and 33 N on S. face; with 6 grooves on N., E. and S. faces; and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high E. of cor. Pits impracticable.

40.00 Set a limestone stone 16-14-9 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the N. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor. Pits impracticable.

A spring bears N. 76° 30' E, 2.15 chs. dist.

45.60 Ridge, bears N. and S. Begin descending.

51.00 Creek, 8 links wide, course N.E. Begin ascending S.E. slope of steep hill.

74.50 High ridge, bears N.E. and S.W. Begin descending.

80.00 Set a limestone stone, 18-9-7 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36; marked with 1 notch on the E. and 5 notches on the W. edge and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.
