Chains	Descending over rolling land.
3.14	Ravine, course S.W.
13.40	Road, bears N.W. and S.E.
19.90	Irrigation ditch, 8 links wide, course S.E.
40.02	Set a granite stone 16-8-5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the N. face and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor. Pits impracticable.
41.20	The dry bed of Squaw Valley creek, course S. Begin ascending.
60.00	Ridge, bears N. and S. Begin descending.
80.04	The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. Land, rolling and mountainous. Soil, gravelly loam and rocky. 2nd. and 4th. rate. Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass. Mountainous land, 36.00 chs.
	W. on a true line bet. secs. 30 and 31. Descending over mountainous land.
12.00	Ravine, course N. Begin ascending.
17.70	Ridge, bears N. and S. Begin descending.
36.10	Ravine, course N.E. Begin ascending.
40.00	Set a basalt stone, 16-9-4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the N. face and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high N. of cor. Pits impracticable.
50.60	Ridge, bears N. and S. Begin descending.
68.00	Ravine, course S.E. Begin ascending.
93.50	Ridge, bears N. and S. Begin descending.
107.50	Intersect the W. bdy of the Tp. at N 0°41'W, 18.80 chs. from the cor. of secs. 25 and 36. Set a basalt stone 17-10-5 ins., 13 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 30 and 31; marked C C on E., with 1 groove on S. and 5 grooves on N. face; and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high E. of cor. Pits impracticable.
