56.40 Small ridge, bears N. and S.

61.75 Ravine, course S.W.

80.00 The cor. of secs. 5,6,7 and 8.

Land, rolling and mountainous.

Soil, rocky. 4th. rate.

Vegetation, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

Mountainous land, 17.50 chs.

W. on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Descending over rolling land.

29.46 Ravine, course S .W.

32.22 Ridge, bears N.E. and S.W.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 17-9-5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for 1-4 sec. cor., marked 1-4 on the W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high W. of cor. Pits impracticable.

65.86 Ravine, course S.W.

68.79 Small ravine, course S.W.

112.05 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp. at N 0°45'W, 11.25 chs. from the cor. of secs. 1 and 12.

Set a basalt stone 21-12-6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 6 and 7, marked C C on E., and with 5 grooves on S. and 1 groove on N. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1-2 ft. high E. of cor. Pits impracticable.

40.00 Set temp. 1-4 cor.
