At 8 h. 2 m. A.M. l.m.t. I set off 390 40' N. on the lat. arc and 120 4' N. on the decl arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24. Thence I run,

89.84 Fall 14 lks W. of the cor. of Tps. 21 and 22 N. R's. 22 and 23 E. which is a cedar post 3 ins square, lying in a mound of stones, with marks almost obliterated. I destroy all traces of the old cor. and in the same place I set an andesite stone 20x10x8 ins. 15 ins in the ground for cor. of Tps. 21 and 22 N. R's 22 and 23 E. marked T 22 N on N.E., R 23 E on S.E., T 21 N on S.W., R 22 E on N.W. face with 6 notches on each edge, from which,

A cedar 8 ins. dia. bears N. 210 45' E 14 lks. dist. marked T 22 N R 23 E S 31 B T.

A cedar 8 ins. dia. bears S. 140 45' E 64 lks. dist. marked T 21 N R 23 E S 6 B T.

A cedar 10 ins. dia. bears S. 190 W. 81 lks. dist. marked T 21 N R 22 E S 1 B T.

A cedar 10 ins. dia bears N. 47030' W. 80 lks dist,
