A cedar 10 ins. dia. bears S. 79o 50' E. 97 lks.
dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T.
A cedar 12 ins. dia. bears N. 66o E. 144 lks. dist.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31 B T.
