At 8h. 10m. A.M. l.m.t. I set off 39 37' N. on the lat. arc and 150 16' N. on the decl arc, and determine a stand. meridian with the solar at the cor. of Tps. 21 N. R's 22 and 23 E. Thence I run S. 89° 51' E. on the S. bdy of sec. 31.

39.15	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on the S. bdy of sec. 31, already described. Thence continue measurement and change course to N. 89° 44' E.
