56.20	Wagon road, bears NW. and SE. Wadsworth and White Horse.
58.00	Pass over rocky land.
80.77	The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, already described. Land level. Soil sandy and stony, 1st. and 2nd. rate. Timber, sagebrush.

73.30	Road, Olinghouse to White Horse Canon, bears NE. and SW.
80.24	The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14 already, described. Land, rolling. Soil, sandy 2nd rate. Timber, sagebrush. Rolling land 81.55 chs.
