

Resurvey of W. Boundary of T. 22 N. R 23 E.

Chains.

May 28th 1910.

At 9 h. A.M. l.m.t. I set off 39o 43' N. on the lat. arc and 21o 24' N. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of Tps. 21 and 22 N. R's 22 and 23 E. Thence I run N. 0o 2' E. on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 36, resurveying as follows:

- 1.00 Small draw, course NW.
- 3.90 Ridge of rock, bears E. and W.
- 9.50 Jones canon, course E.
- 16.50 Ridge, bears E. and W.
- 34.20 Canon, course SE.
- 39.99 Set an andesite stone 20x8x6 ins. 15 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which,
- A cedar 5 ins. dia. bears S. 40o 45' W. 24 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 B T.
- A cedar 8 ins dia. bears S 8o 30' E. 82 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31 B T.
- 46.30 Spur, bears SE and NW.
- 55.60 Draw, course SE.
- 60.40 Knob of rock on line.
- 79.98 Set an andesite stone 20x10x6 ins. 15 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, marked with 1 notch on the S. and 5 notches on the N. edge; and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.
- Pits impracticable.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, stony 3rd. rate.
- Timber, cedar and sagebrush.
- Mountainous land, 79.98 chs.

N. 0o 2' W. bet. secs 25 and 30.

Descend.

- 12.00 Canon, course E.
- 39.99 Set an andesite stone 20x14x4 ins. 15 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.
