

Resurvey of Subdivisions of T. 22 N. R. 23 E.

Chains.

Oct. 3rd. 1910.

At 9 hrs. A.M. l.m.t. I set off 39° 43' N. on the lat. arc and 30° 47' S. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35. Thence I run,

78.30 Fall 38 lks. N. of the old cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Line bears S 89° 47' W.
