

Seventh Standard Parallel South, through Range 66 East.

Chains

Survey commenced May 1, 1911, and executed with a Keuffel and Esser solar transit No. 20575. For the description of the transit, see Book A. I begin at the standard corner of townships 28 south, ranges 65 and 66 east, reset by me on this date.

At 3^h 57^m p. m., l. m. t., I set off 35° 27' N. on the lat. arc; 14° 59' N. on the decl. arc; and determine a true meridian with the solar.

Thence I run

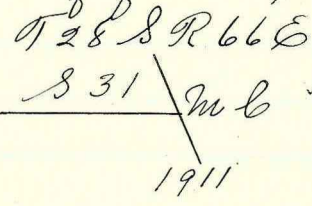
East on S. bdy. of sec. 31.

Over level land, through chaparral and willows.

2.00 Old road bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.

5.95 Right bank of Colorado River.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for standard meander corner of fractional W. half of sec. 31, with brass cap marked



and dig pit, 36 x 36 x 12 ins., 8 ft. W. of cor., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy loam; 1st rate.

No timber.
