

Recovery of the West Boundary of T. 29 S., R. 66 E. west
of Secs. 6-7 and 18

Chains

Preliminary to commencing the subdivision of the township, I retrace the west bdy. as follows, May 2, 1911, at 7^h 57^m a.m., by ~~the~~ ^{the} set off 35° 27' N. on the lat. arc; 15° 11' N. on the decl. arc, and determine a true meridian with the solat, at the closing cor. of townships 29 S., ranges 65 and 66 E., which I reestablished on the re-tracement of the seventh Standard Parallel South, through range 65 E.

Thence I run

South bet. secs. 1 and 6

33.00 Road to Searchlight bears N. 85° W. and S. 85° E.

40.48 Intersect old cor., badly broken

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

80.48 Intersect the exact point of old sec. cor., as plainly shown by the mound.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap marked
