

Subdivision of T. 8 S., R. 67 E.

- Drains Over rough, mountainous land, through scattering shade-cedar and scrub cedar, descend
- 2.50 Gulch, 50 ft. below sec. cor., drains S. 79° E.; ascend abruptly
- 17.25 Ridge, 300 ft. above gulch, bears N. 75° W. and S. 75° E.; descend abruptly
- 32.50 Gulch, 400 ft. below ridge, drains S. 80° E.; ascend abruptly
- 37.50 Point of spur, 120 ft. above gulch, projects E.; descend
- 40.35 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, in drain, 24 in. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. 56 $\frac{1}{4}$ | 55
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and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- 48.90 Gulch, 175 ft. below spur, drains N. 70° E.; ascend abruptly
- 59.00 Ridge, 375 ft. above gulch, bears E. and S. 80° W.; descend abruptly over broken ledges
- 71.20 Head of gulch, 300 ft. below ridge, drains E.; ascend abruptly over broken ledges
- 77.20 Spur, 200 ft. above gulch, projects S. 80° E.; descend abruptly over broken ledges.
- 80.35 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8
This cor. is 125 ft. below top of spur.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky; 4th rate.
Timber, scrub cedar, 80.35 chs.
Mountainous land, 80.35 chs.
