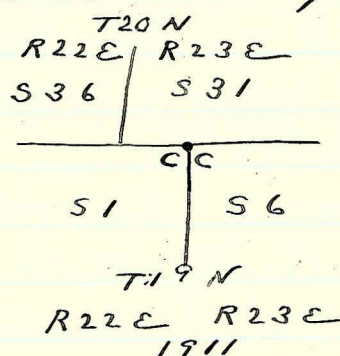

Since some of the corners are gone and others in poor condition it will be necessary to resurvey this line.

I destroy all traces of the closing corner of T 19 N, R's. 22 and 23 E, and its accessories and reestablish it at the same point as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of T 19 N, R's. 22 and 23 E, with brass cap mkd.



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high S. of cor.

Thence I run

S 0° 4' W. bet. secs. 1 and 6

Over mountainous land.

- 9.37 Ravine, course N. W.
- 21.00 Dry wash, course N. W.
- 21.30 Road, bears N. W. and S. E.
- 31.00 Dry wash, course N. W.
- 36.78 Telephone line, bears N. W. and S. E.
- 47.77 The old ¼ sec. cor.

I destroy all traces of this old corner and its accessories and reestablish it at the same point as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.
