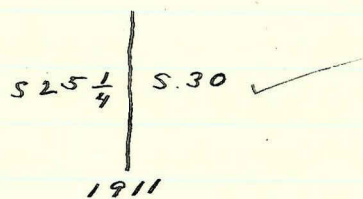


Chains.

24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
with brass cap m'kd.



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft.
base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.

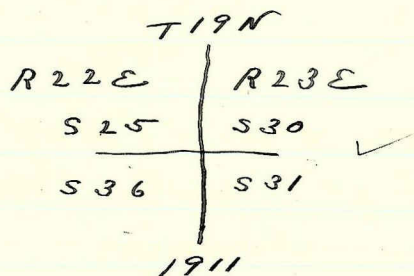
60.30 Large ravine, course N. W.

70.00 Small ravine, course N. W.

80.00 The old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36.

I destroy all traces of this old cor.
and its accessories and reestablish
it at the same point as follows:

diam. 24 ins. in the ground for
cor. of secs 25, 30, 31 and 36 with
brass cap m'kd.



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft.
