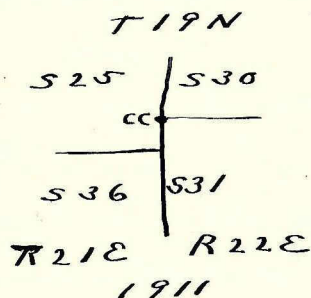


Subdivision of T19N, R22E

76.40 and raise a mound of stone 2 ft.
base, 1½ ft. high N. of cor.
102.20 Rocky ridge, bears N. and S.
Intersect W. bdy. of tp. at N 0° 19' E.
1.10 chs. from the cor. of secs. 25
and 36, re-established by me June 7,
1911.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins.
diam. 24 ins. in the ground for
closing corner of secs. 30 and 31
with brass cap mkt.
