

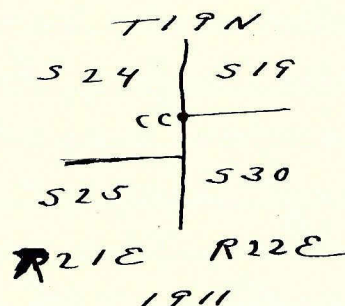
Subdivision of T19N R22E

Intrsect the W. bdy. of the tp. at $N 0^{\circ} 43' E$, 1.50 chs. from the cor. of secs. 24 and 25, re-established by me June 7, 1911.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 19 and 30 with brass cap m'kd.



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high E. of cor. Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky. 4th. rate, covered with basalt rocks, loose and in place. Wholly unfit for cultivation. Fair growth sagebrush, little grass, scrubby, scattering junipers. No mineral indications. Land of very little value.

$N 0^{\circ} 1' E$ bet. secs. 19 and 20

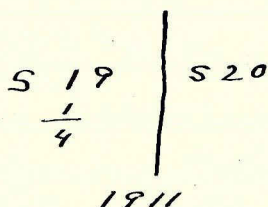
Over mountainous land.
