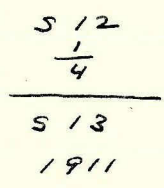
Chains.

dig pits 18x18x12 ins. in each sec.
 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high N. of cor.
 Land, mountainous.
 Soil, rocky. 4th rate, wholly unfit for cultivation. Good growth sagebrush, little grass, scattering junipers. Basalt mountains, no signs of mineral, land of very little value.

2.8956' E on a true line, bet. secs. 12 and 13.

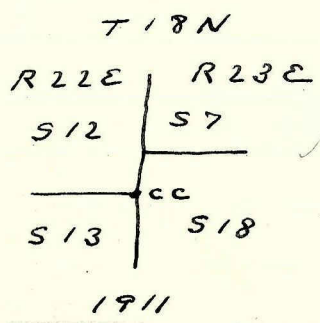
Over mountainous land.

- 2.85 Flat ravine, course S.
- 15.50 Mountain ridge, bears N. and S.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap m'kd.



dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high N. of cor.

- 42.50 Head of ravine, course N.E.
- 55.00 Ridge, bears N.E. and S.W.
- 59.37 Road, bears N.E. and S.W.
- 80.69 Intersect the E. bdy. of the tp. at S., 93 lks. from the cor. of secs. 7 and 18 re-established by me July 7, 1911
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 12 and 13 with brass cap m'kd.
