Chains


N 0° 1' W, on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over mountainous land.

24.25 Road, bears N. E. and S. W.

38.30 Ravine, course westerly

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap mkt'd.




and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high W. of cor.

58.00 Mountain ridge, bears N. E. and S. W.

64.80 Ravine, course W.

78.80 Intersect the N. bdy. of the tp. at W, 1.59 chs. from the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, established by me June 1911.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkt'd.



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high S. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky. 4th. rate, wholly unfit for cultivation. Good growth sagebrush, little grass, scattering junipers. Basalt mountains, no signs of mineral. Land of very little value.
