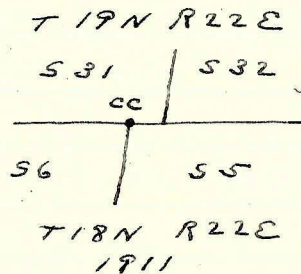

- 38.20 Ridge, bears E. and W.
- 40.00 Set a basalt stone  $21 \times 8 \times 5$  ins.  
14 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face; and  
raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base  
 $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W. of cor.
- 55.50 Ravine, course S. W.
- 77.10 Rocky hill, bears E. and W.
- 78.74 Intersect the N. bdy. of the tp. at  
W., 1.61 chs. from the cor. of secs.  
31 and 32, established by me June  
, 1911.
- Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins.  
diam. 24 ins. in the ground for
