


## Resurvey of the W. bdy. T 24N, R 25E.

S 3° 20' W. bet. secs. 31 and 36


Over rough basalt mountains.

Descend S. E. slope of mountain.

39.91 The old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

I destroy all traces of this corner  
and its accessories and re-establish  
it at the same point as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long,  
1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground  
for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap whid

63.00 Mountain spur, slopes W.
