General Description.

In secs. 33, 34, 35, the western part of secs. 25 and 36; and the southern part of secs. 26, 27, 28 the land is level. Good, rich soil, derived from granite and volcanic rocks. Secs. 1, 2, 3, 4, 11 and 12 are mostly rolling hills and low mountains, the northeastern part is granite, and the rest volcanic rocks. On the granite formation is some bunch grass.

The rest of the township is volcanic mountains, mostly, high, rough and barren. In sec. 3 and the N.E. ¼ of sec. 6 is much good looking quartz flint and good mineral indications. No part of this township can be cultivated without irrigation and there is no water available at present for this purpose. There is no springs or living water in this township and no settlers.
