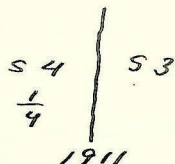

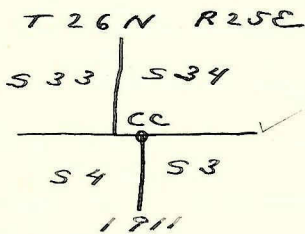
- 1.75 Wash, course S.E.
- 4.55 Wash, course S.E.
- 8.80 Wash, course S.E.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.

- 43.40 Ravine, course S.E.
- 49.70 Small ravine, course E.
- 58.25 Road, bears N.E. and S.W.
- 72.90 Intersect the 5th. Standard Parallel North, at S. 89° 50' E, 10.74 chs. from the standard corner of secs. 33 and 34; re-established by me Sept. 29, 1911.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 3 and 4. with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins. crosswise on each line E. and W, 3 ft. and S. of post, 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, level.

Soil; good, gravelly, sandy desert loam. 1st. rate. Derived from the disintegration of granite rocks. Good growth sage-bush, little grass, no timber.
