Ascending rolling mountain

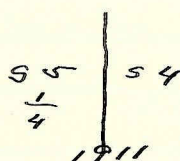
6.15 Ridge, bears N.W. and S.E.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in.

 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of
post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound
of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high
W. of cor.

40.10 Wash, course S.E.

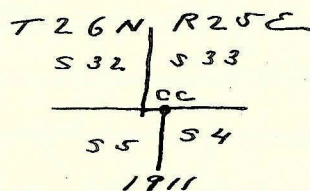
43.68 Ravine, course E.
