Chains

Soil, gravelly and stony, and rocky.
3rd. and 4th. rate. Unfit for cultivation.

E. 62.00 chs. is rolling with gravelly, stony soil.

W. 18.00 chs. is mountainous, with rocky soil. On entire distance is good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber, slopes easterly.

- W. on a true line bet. secos. 7 and 18.
ascending basalt mountain.
- 14.00 Top of basalt mountain, bears N.W. and S.E.
descend S.W. slope of mountain.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in.
diam. 2 1/4 ins. in the ground for 1/4
sec. cor. with brass cap inked

- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base
1 1/2 ft. high N. of cor.
- 43.85 Ravine, course S.E.

- 58.55 Small ravine, course S.E.
- 66.70 Large ravine, course S.E.
- 67.44 Intercept the W. bdy. of the tpi. at
50.26 W, 76 lks. from the cor. of secos.
12 and 13; re-established by me Sept. 28,
1911.
- Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam.
2 1/4 ins. in the ground for closing corner
of secos. 7 and 18, with brass cap inked.
