Land rolling.

Soil, rocky 4th rate.


Low scattering sagebrush undergrowth. No timber.

N.0°2'W. on a random line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

111.20 Intersect N. bdy. of Tp. 7.99 chs. W. of cor. of secs. 34 and 35, described in book of exteriors.

At point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3 with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high

S. of cor. Thence I run

S.0°2'E. on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over descending ground.

19.20 Bottom of canyon, 1.50 chs. wide, 80 ft. below closing cor. course E., asc.

23.20 Top of rocky spur, 140 ft. above canyon, bears N.71°E. and S.71°W., thence gradually desc. along E. slope of ridge.

47.00 Foot of descent, enter level canyon, 6 chs. wide, 150 ft. below point of spur, course N.78°E.

51.20 Small creek from spring, 5 lks. wide, 4 ins. deep, clear water, gentle current, course N.78°E.

51.85 Small creek, branch of the above 3 lks. wide, 2 ins. deep course E.

53.00 Begin ascent.

59.00 Top of spur, 90 ft. above canyon, bears N.81°E. and S.81°W., desc.

71.20 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.

73.80 Bottom of canyon, 1.70 chs. wide, 80 ft. below top of spur course N.3°E., ascend.

82.95 Recross above canyon, course N.35°E., thence ascend NW. Slope of ridge.

111.20 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.

Land mountainous.
