79.92 The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.

Land mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd rate.

Sage and bunchgrass.

West bet. secs. 19 and 30.

Desc. over mountainous land.

5.00 Head of draw, course S.15°W. Asc.

13.00 Top of ridge, extends S.7°W. Desc. abruptly W. side of mountain.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:

$$\begin{array}{r} S\ 19 \\ \frac{1}{4} \\ \hline S\ 30 \\ 1910 \end{array}$$

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cor.

Land mountainous.

Soil, rocky 3rd rate.

Sage and bunchgrass.

From $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to secs. 19 and 30, previously established by A. B. Rich, U.S. Transitman, I run W. on a true line.

Ascend over rolling hills.

13.21 Small draw, course S.6°W.

17.00 Top of spur, Bears S.10°E. and N.10°W. Desc.

19.82 Bottom of canyon, course S.14°E.

Ascend over small spur.

28.00 Top of small spur, bears E. and W. Desc.

38.00 Draw, course SE. Asc.

42.40 Intersect the east bdy. of sec. 25, 1 ch. 30 lks. S.

of the corner to secs. 24 and 25, heretofore described.

At point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long

2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in ground for corner to secs. 19 and 30, with a brass cap mkd:
