Desc. over mountainous land.

2.20 Head of draw, course N.22°E. Asc.

24.00 Spur, projects N.10°W. Desc.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:
$$\begin{array}{r} S 7 \\ \frac{1}{4} \\ \hline S 18 \\ 1910 \end{array}$$

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high
N. of cor.

Land rolling mountains.

Soil, rocky, 3rd rate.

Sage and bunchgrass.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to sec. 7 and 18, previously estab-
lished by A. B. Rich, U.S. Transitman, I run

West on a true line.

Gradual descent.

14.19 Bottom of swayle, course SW., desc.

30.00 Top of spur, bears E. and W. Desc.

42.19 Intersect east bdy. section 13, 1 ch. 33 lks.

south of the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, heretofore
described.

At point of intersection I set an iron post 3 ft. long,
2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. to
secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd:
