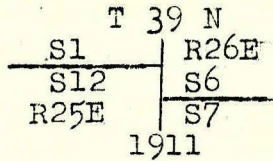


Chains

At point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in ground for cor. to secs. 6 and 7 with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high east of corner.

Land mountainous. Soil rocky, 4th rate.

No timber.

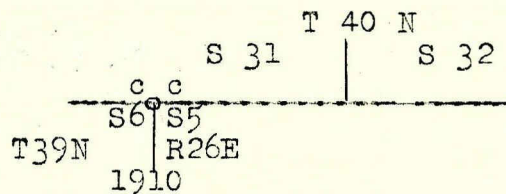
Mountainous land 40 chs.

N.0°04'W. on a random line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

40.00 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.

111.03 Intersect N. bdy. of Tp. 7.71 chs. W. of cor. of secs. 31 and 32, heretofore described.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd:



and dig pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each line, E. and W., 3 ft. and S. of stone 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high S. of cor. Thence I run

S.0°04'E. on a true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over level land, through high sage.

43.00 Foot of mountain, leave high sage. Asc.

60.50 Top of mountain, bears E. and W.

Over gently rolling flat top mountain.

70.80 Top of cliff, 50 ft. high, bears E. and W. Desc. abruptly S. slope of mountain.

71.03 Foot of cliff.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:
