## GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township is almost entirely mountainous. It has some rugged cliffs and deep canyons, some mesas and some high rolling hills.

The soil ranges from a rich sandy loam, as found in the valleys of some of the water courses, to solid rock cliffs. Much of the land near Piute Creek is thickly strewn with loose lava rocks. Piute Creek heads in the southern part of the township and has a southeasterly course. A tributary of this creek flows through the eastern part of the township with a southerly course. A third creek flows from the northwestern part of the township with a westerly course. The township is therefore well
