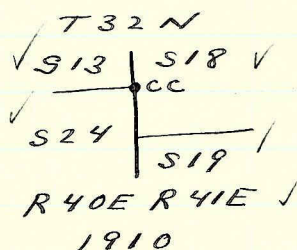


Subdivision in T 32 N R 40 E.

chains

- 45.00 Small ridge, bears N. and S.
 47.10 Wash, course northerly.
 56.90 Ravine, course N. W.
 67.00 Mountain spur, slopes N.
 80.00 Intersect the E. bdy. of the tp. at
 N 0° 6' E, 90 links from the cor. of
 secs. 18 and 19.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins.
 diam. 24 ins. in the ground for
 closing corner of secs. 13 and 24
 with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins. crosswise on
 each line, N. and S., 3 ft. and W. of
 post 8 ft. dist.; and raise a mound
 of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high
 W. of cor.

 4th. rate. Mountains are of
 lime and eruptive rocks, mostly
 covered with wash. Little min-
 eral indications. Covered with
 a good growth of sagebrush,
 little grass, scattering juniper
 trees.
