

Subdivision in T 32 N, R 40 E.

Chains

63.60

Ridge, bears N. E. and S. W

66.30

Ravine, course S. W.

74.00

Mountain spur, slopes S. W.

80.29.

Intersect the N. bdy. of the tp. at N 89° 46' W, 66 links ^W from the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35. I change the markings and accessories on this corner to refer only to Secs. 34 and 35, T 33 N, R 40 E.

Set a limestone 21 x 12 x 8 ins.; 14 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, marked C. C. on south; with 2 grooves on E. and 4 grooves on W. face and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high S. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 4th. rate. Unfit for cultivation. Mountains are of lime and eruptive rocks, mostly covered with wash, little mineral indications. Covered with a good growth of sagebrush, little grass, no timber.
