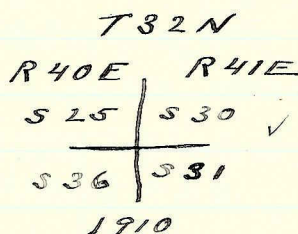

18.00 Mountain spur, slopes N. E.

23.75 Small ravine, course N. E.

34.00 Mountain spur, slopes N. E.

37.15 Ravine, course N. E.

40.00 On north side of mountain spur.

Set a granite stone $17 \times 10 \times 5$ ins.

12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face and

raise a mound of stone 2 ft.

base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.

48.00 Mountain spur, slopes E.

62.85 Deep ravine, course N. E., begin as-
cent of steep, rocky mountain.

80.00 Intersect the prolongation of the
S. bdy. of the tp. at 3.96 chs. west
of the temp. cor. of Tps. 31 and 32 N,
Rs. 40 and 41 E. This makes the line
S. of sec. 31, 83.35 chs. long.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long.
