

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35; with brass cap mkt.



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high W. of cor.

Land, rolling.
Soil, gravelly loam to rocky; 2nd. and 3rd. rate. The soil is of good quality derived from the disintegration of lime, granite and eruptive rocks. but too uneven and containing too many stones. Covered with a good growth of sagebrush, little grass, no timber.


