

Resurvey of the N. bdy. of T32 N, R42 E.

chains.

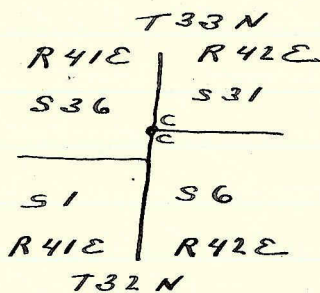
32 and 33 N., Rs. 42 and 43 E., following
72 links S. of my line.

It is a redwood post, 3 x 4 ins. by
18 ins. long. Set in a mound of
stone and marked with 6 notches
on each of the N., S., E. and W. edges.

Since some of the corners are gone,
the others in poor condition and
nearly all parts of this bdy. out of
limits in distance, it will be
necessary to resurvey it, so I return
to the closing tp. cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N.
R42 E and resurvey as follows:

I destroy all traces of the closing
tp. cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., R42 E, and
its accessories and reestablish it
at the same point as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins.
diam., 24 ins. in the ground for
closing tp. corner of Tps. 32 and 33 N.
R42 E, with brass cap mk'd.



dig pits, 30 x 24 x 12 ins., crosswise on each
line, N. and S., 4 ft., and E. of post, 8 ft.
dist.; and raise a mound of earth,
5 ft. base, 2 1/2 ft. high E. of cor.

Thence I run

N 89° 40' E on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 31

Over level land.
