

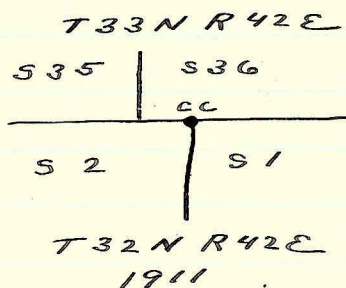

45.40 Ravine, course N.W.

78.45 Intersect the N. bdy. of the tp. at  $589^{\circ}55'E$ , 1.20 cho. from the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, re-established by me April 29, 1911.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap m'kd.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky. 4th rate, wholly unfit for cultivation.

Good growth of sagebrush, little grass, no timber. Low mountains of lime and volcanic rocks.

I commence at the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the tp. established by me May 1, 1911.

At 8 h, a.m., local mean time, I set off  $49^{\circ}25'$  N. on the lat arc,  $16^{\circ}20'30''$  N. on the decl. arc. and determine a true meridian with the solar.

Thence I run.
