

Chains.

August 19, 1911: Preliminary to the completion, of the subdivision of this township. I set my transit up over the cor. of secs, 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. Bdy. of T.39 N., R.18 E. (here to fore) described, and fore sight to tack in peg, set on true meridian, previously established by me on August, 1, 1911. I lay off from the true meridian an angle of 90° from north to west. and run.

West., on a blank line along the S. bdy. of T.39 N., R. 18 E.

- 39.75 Fall N. of old 1/4 sec. bet. secs. 3 and 34., 22 lks. dist.,
- 78.02 Fall S. of old cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34., 32 lks. dist.,
- 116.50 Fall N. of old 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 4 and 33. 55 lks. dist.,
- 158.21 Fall N. of old cor. of secs 4, 5, 32 and 33. 1.12chs. dist.,
- 199.21 After a diligent search, was unable to find any trace of old 1/4 sec. cor bet. secs. 5 and 32. which is described as a trap stone, 8x6x3 ins., in a earth mound, 4ft. base, 2ft. high.
- 231.81 After a diligent search was unable to find any trace of old closing cor. of T.38 and 39 N., R.18 E. which is described as a trap stone 10x8x6 ins., in a earth mound, 4-1/2 ft. in diam., at base, by 2ft. in height. with pits, N, S and E., 8 ft. dist.,

Note: As T.38 N., R.18 E. is subdivided. I resurvey the Bdy. line bet. T.38 and 39 N. as follows.

Set my transit up over the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35. on the south Bdy. of Tp. and fore sight to tack in peg
