

Chains.

- 40.90 Top of bluff, 35 ft. above foot, bears N. and S. ascend.
- 43.30 Enter junipers, bears N. and S.
- 45.50 Top of ascent, 40 ft. above top of bluff, thence over level table land.
- 49.35 Edge of bluff, bears NW. and SE. abrupt descent.
- 49.40 Foot of bluff, 55 ft. below top, bears NW. and SE. descend
- 52.00 Leave junipers, bears N. and S. enter thick sage brush under growth.
- 60.00 Foot of descent, 80 ft. below foot of bluff, bears N. 30° W., and S. 30° E. thence over level land.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins in the ground, for standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32. with brass cap mkd:



and dig pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each line, E. and W., 3 ft. and N. of post, 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Land, level and rolling.

Thick sage brush, undergrowth. 28.00 chs.
