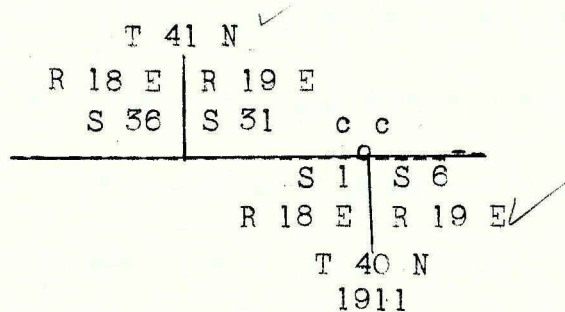


Chains.

August 9, 1911: I reestablish the closing cor. of Tps. 40 N. Rs. 18, 19 E. according to the old field notes, as follows. At a point on the 8th. Standard Parallel North. 53.72 chs. East of the established Standard cor. of Tps. 41 N., R. 18, 19 E. I set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of Tps. 40 N., R. 18, 19 E. with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1-1/2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From the closing Tp. cor. above described. I run S. on a blank line, along the E.bdy. of T. 40 N., R. 18 E. ✓

At 40.00 chs. find no trace of old 1/4 sec. cor. bet.

secs. 1 and 6, which is described as a trap stone 12x12 x16, 8 ins. in the ground, with 2 pits. and at 80.00 chs.

find no trace of old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12. which is described as a trap stone 10x12x20, 10 ins. in the

ground, with 4 pits. and at 120.00 chs. find no trace

of old 1/4 sec. cor. bet secs. 7 and 12. which is de-

scribed as a trap stone 10x14x16, 8 ins. in the ground,

with 2 pits. and at 160.00 chs. find no trace of old cor.

of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18. which is described as a trap

stone 12x13x18, 8 ins. in the ground, with 4 pits.
