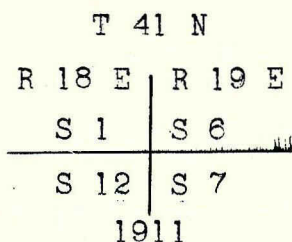


Chains.

- 65.00 Bottom of draw, 2.00 chs. wide, 70 ft. below top of spur. course N.65°00'E. ascend.
- 67.00 Dry wash, 15 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, 30 ft. above draw, course SW.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam, 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 1,6,7 and 12. with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1-1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay and rocks. 3rd and 4th rate.

Low scattering sage brush, undergrowth.

No timber.

Drainage, S. and W.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over ascending ground.

- 13.00 Enter scattering Junipers. bears E. and W.
- 31.00 Top of ridge, 80 ft. above sec. cor. bears E. and W. descend.
- 32.20 Leave junipers. bears E. and W.
- 34.00 Enter quaking-asp timber. bears E. and W.
- 35.00 Leave quaking-asp timber. bears E. and W.
- 36.50 Bottom of ravine, 30 lks. wide, 10 ft. deep, 100 ft. below
