General Description.

This fractional township is almost entirely exceptionally rough and rugged, being in the heart of the Jackson Mountains. Some parts of the township are several thousand feet higher than other parts. The western edge of the tract is at the eastern edge of the Black Rock Desert and consequently in the foothills. The township is well watered, one of the principal streams being Jackson Creek, which flows through the southern part of the township with a northwesterly course. It probably flows nearly or quite the entire year.

The soil of the mountainous portions is for the most part very rocky, and of value only for grazing. There is a scattering
