

## Resurvey of E. Bdy. T.15 N., R. 57 E.

Chs.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd:

from which:  
 A cedar 6 ins. in dia. bears N.40°50'E., 77 lks. dist. mkd. T15NR58ES30BT.  
 A cedar 10 ins. in dia. bears S.19°50'E., 1.89 chs. dist., mkd. T15NR58ES31BT.  
 A cedar 5 ins. in dia. bears S.17°05'W., 1.77 chs. dist., mkd. T15NR57ES36BT.  
 A cedar 10 ins. in dia. bears N.10°25'W., 68 lks. dist. mkd. T15NR57ES25BT.  
 Corner is 245 ft. below spur.  
 Land, mountainous. General exposure and drainage to the SE.  
 Soil, loose rock and coarse gravel on surface, 3 to 6 ins. deep on a subsoil of hard, stiff, white sandy loam of medium texture and coarse gravel; scattering cedars and pinon; medium sagebrush, rabbit brush, buckbrush and scattering bunchgrass with fair grazing on 80 chs.  
 Sept. 23, 1914: At 11 h 53 m A.M., l.m.t., I set off 0° 02½'N. on the decl. arc, and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 39°07'.

South on resurvey along the E. Bdy. of the township, between secs. 31 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through scattering cedars and pinon pine, medium undergrowth of sagebrush, buck brush, rabbit brush, shadscale and scattering bunch grass.

Descend.

Leave timber, bears E. and W.

North side and bottom canyon, 50 ft. below corner, drains SW.

Thence South on nearly level line across bottom of canyon.

Dry wash, 40 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep, course W.

After diligent search found no trace of old ¼ sec. cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

from which:

A cedar 12 ins. in dia. bears N.80°35'E., 3.77 chs: dist., mkd. ¼S31BT.

A cedar 5 ins. in dia. bears S.72°40'W., 3.11 chs. dist., mkd. ¼S36BT.

South side and bottom of canyon, drains NW.

Ascend.

Enter dense timber, bears NW. and SE.

Top of spur, 200 ft. above canyon, bears N.60°E. 15 chs. dist.

Descend.

After diligent search found no trace of old township corner.

A pinon 8 ins. in dia. bears N.67°E., 59 lks. dist.,
