1½ ft. high N. of cor.

Leave rolling land, thence across rolling mountains, with scattering timber

57.30 Mountain spur, slopes southerly

60.10 Small ravine, course S.W.

67.30 Mountain spur, slopes S.W.

69.10 Small ravine, course S.W.

75.00 Rocky mountain spur, slopes S.W.

Set a light colored volcanic stone 18 x 8 x 6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for standard cor. of sec. 31 and 32, marked with 5 grooves on the E and 1 groove on the W. face, and S.C on the north face; and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high N. of cor.

Soil, thin, poor and rocky, 3rd. and 4th. rate.

Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber on E. 40.00 chs., scattering juniper and mahogany on W. 40.00 chs. General southerly slope.
