

Resurvey of the E. Bdy. of T.36 N., R.62 E.

Chains


dist., mkd. T36NR62E S1BT.
 Land, rolling W. slope.
 Draws and washes contain very fine, rich alluvial soil with no rocks.
 At $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., yellow, gravelly soil. Very stony; solid outcrops of limestone and quartzite. At section corner, gravelly, yellow clay, containing adobe. Very cold, 1 ft. deep on hardpan. Patches of juniper and pinon pine on south half of mile. Dense timber on the north half of mile. Juniper, pinon pine and mountain mahogany. Sagebrush undergrowth throughout the mile.

N.1°11'W. on a resurvey between secs. 1 and 6.
 Over rolling W. and SW. slope, through dense timber.
 4.00 Spur of ridge, 5 ft. above section corner, bears SW.
 Leave dense timber, bears with ridge.
 8.00 Shallow draw, 7 ft. below spur, course SW.
 8.20 Old wood road, bears SW. and NE.
 10.00 Enter dense, heavy timber, bears E. and W.
 39.00 Old wood road, bears E. and W.
 40.01 Old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Alongside, I set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



from which:
 A pinon pine 10 ins. in dia., bears S.87 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E. 13 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S6BT.
 A pinon pine 10 ins. in dia., bears N.7 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W. 62 lks., dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S1BT.
 Thence N.0°11'E.

43.20 Old road, bears E. and W.
 43.40 Bottom of draw, 30 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., course W.
 63.30 Old wood road, bears NE. and SW.
 79.87 The old township corner heretofore described. In an old mound of earth I set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rs. 62 and 63 E., with brass cap mkd:



from which:
 A pinon pine 7 ins. in dia. bears N.87°45'E., 65 lks. dist., mkd: T37NR63E S31BT.
 A pinon pine 6 ins. in dia. bears S.73°30'E., 72 lks. dist., mkd. T36NR63E S6BT.
 A pinon pine 5 ins. in dia. bears S.88°15'W., 62 lks. dist., mkd. T36NR62E S1BT.
 A pinon pine 4 ins. in dia. bears N.5°W., 65 lks. dist., mkd. T37NR62E S36BT.

This corner is 100 ft. above the draw.
 Land, rolling ascent of mountain.
 Medium, gravelly, clay loam. Rich, fairly loose and moist.
 Stiff, cold clay subsoil, Dense pinon pine and juniper, and a few mountain mahogany. Dense, heavy sagebrush.
